

Poker Hand Ranking Explained

| Royal Flush | A K ♦ | Q ♠ J ♠ | Ace, King, Queen, Jack, Ten, all of the same suit |
|-----------------|---|-----------------------------|---|
| Straight Flush | J ♣ ₽ | 9 8 + | Five cards of the same suit in sequential order |
| Four of a Kind | T ◆ T ◆ | | Any four matching cards |
| Full House | A ◆ A ◆ | | Combination of three of a kind and a pair in the same hand |
| Flush | Q 9 4 | 6 5 ♦ | Five cards of the same suit |
| Straight | J • | 9 ♥ 8 ♥ | Five cards in sequential order, in any suit |
| Three of a kind | A A A A A A A A A | | Any three matching cards |
| Two pair | J | 5 5 • | Two different pairs in the same hand |
| One pair | Q | J | Any two matching cards |
| High Card | Q • | 7 6 • | The highest ranked card in your hand with an ace being the highest. |
